## **Summary**

Dr. Abraham Johnson currently serves as Church Administrator under the leadership of Bishop Terry Fitzgerald, Pastor of Faith Apostolic Christian Tabernacle Services, Havana Florida. He was consecrated Bishop and appointed advisor to the Church of God Apostolic, Inc., Board of Bishops (2008). Previously, he and his wife, Minister Mittie P. ## **The Family**

Abraham Johnson, Jr., born March 25, 1951, to the late Abe, Sr. and Azalee Johnson, grew up within site distance of the Apalachicola Bay, in the small fishing town of Apalachicola, Florida. He credits the beginning of his awareness of God to his early years of attending a local church, with his parents, five sisters and two brothers. Abraham is the husband of Mittie Pollock-Johnson, of forth-years. They are the parents of two married Sons: Abe, III and wife Trina and Derek and wife Kenya. They are also the proud grandparents of five grandchildren.

## **The Ministry**

It was at a local church meeting, the summer of 1977, the Johnson's repented and accepted the Lordship of Christ Jesus (Acts 2:14-42.) This Biblical Conversion, one year later, led Abraham to understand and accept his call to ministry. The Rev. Dr. E. D. Dixon, pastor of Tabernacle Baptist Church (Greenville South Carolina) licensed Abraham Johnson, September 03, 1978. He began to preach the Gospel as he had opportunity, and to exercise his gifts in the work of the Ministry.

Abraham Johnson initial ordination, July 13, 1981, and served as the Minister of Christian Education for Mount Pleasant Baptist Church, Atlanta, Georgia under the leadership of the Rev. O. L. Blackshear, Pastor. He graduated from Emory University earning the Master of Divinity Degree, December 1981. God opened the door for Dr. Johnson, April 17, 1984 to receive another ordination to preach. He was set apart as Minister of the Full-Gospel of Christ Jesus, Smith Chapel Apostolic Overcomers Holiness Church of Christ, Apalachicola Florida. Dr. Johnson completed the requirements for his first doctoral degree and earned, with honors, the Doctor of Theology Degree, June 24, 1994. His latest publication "*The Dialectical Method of Biblical Exegesis: A Revelation Paradigm for Students Taught by the Holy Spirit Studying Scripture*" Volume I Trafford Publishing 2003 (Volume II Pending) completed the requirements for candidacy to the Doctor of Philosophy from Intercultural Open University, Netherlands.
